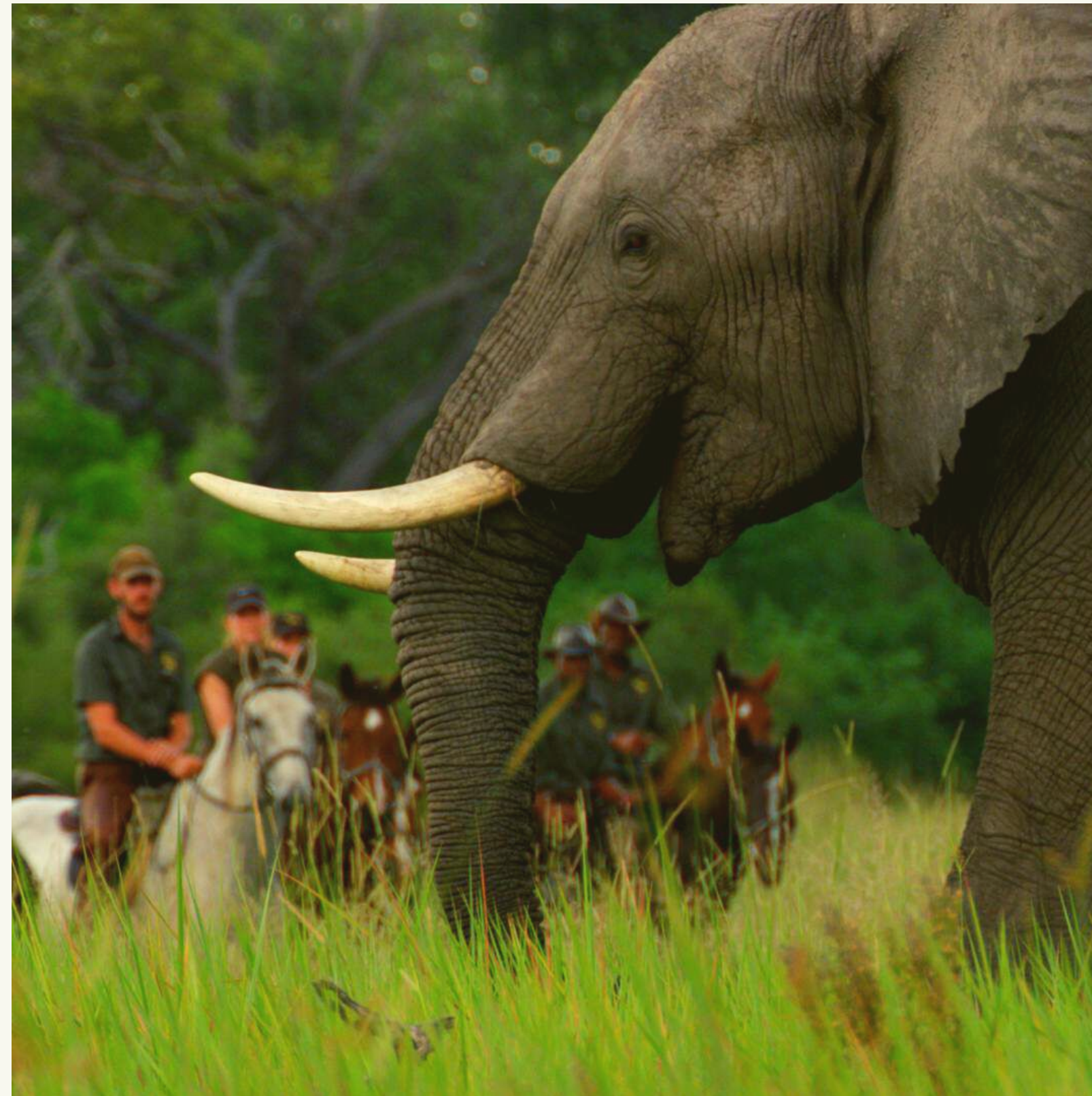

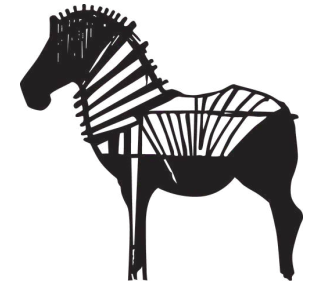

NIGHT RIDING SAFARI

A 10-night itinerary is the perfect way to learn about the intricacies of the Delta. Guests explore the area around Kujwana Camp, a wilderness in the heart of the Okavango Delta, enjoying wonderful riding with picnic lunches, mokoros, a bush dinner, walks, game drives and power boats (water permitting.) Guests also have the opportunity to spend two nights at our fly-camp a truly adventurous addition to the safari and a further night at our sleep out platforms.



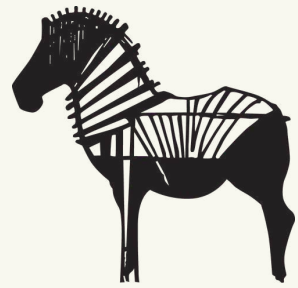


DAY 1

You'll be met at Maun Airport before a 20 minute transfer by helicopter straight into Kujwana camp, or by light aircraft to the nearest airstrip, which is then roughly an hour's drive to camp by vehicle or boat (water permitting).

Once you arrive in camp you will be given time to settle into your spacious tents before lunch/afternoon tea and an introductory talk. This is followed by an orientation ride for approximately 1.5 - 2 hours.

Dinner with your guides and other guests in our lovely raised dining area.



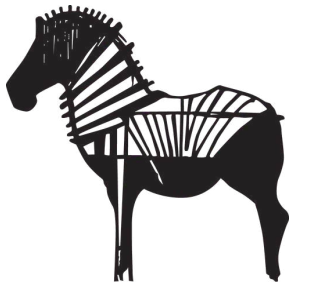
DAY 2

You'll be woken up in the early morning with a tray of tea or coffee to enjoy in bed whilst listening to the sounds of the bush.

After breakfast, a morning ride in the Xudum area, wading through lush green molapos that lead you from island to island, surprising a timid reedbuck out his dense cover on a heavily wooded island, or enjoy the herds of elephant, buffalos and zebra moving through the open spaces.

Return to camp for lunch followed by a siesta or a swim in the pool. In the late afternoon head out for a peaceful mokoro expedition on the river and enjoy the tranquility of the Delta from our dug out canoes. Soak up the beautiful colours of the Delta as the sun starts to sink behind the horizon.





DAY 3

A full day ride from Kujwana Camp, of approximately 30km heading to our flycamp. The route moves through open floodplains and scattered islands towards the Qwaapu river system, where you will see a wide variety of game.

A picnic lunch is served on a shady island followed by a siesta with camp beds, maybe a swim, and then a further 2 hours ride in the afternoon. Arrive at our wonderful fly camp at sunset and enjoy a refreshing drink as you admire the stunning views over the floodplain.

You'll find luxurious tents with comfortable beds, hot showers in your ensuite bathroom and a large mess tent complete with sofas and a library. Fall asleep to the sounds of your horse munching its hay on the picket line.



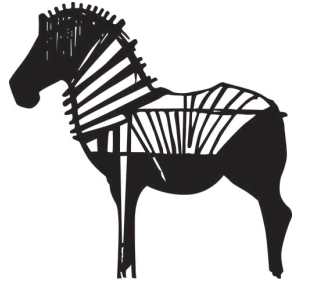


DAY 4

To give your horse a rest we'll spend the morning on a game drive incorporating a bush walk and tracking. A drive is the perfect time to go looking for predators, including the endangered African Wild Dog and the numerous leopards we find in this area.



Lunch, a siesta and perhaps some games in camp before an afternoon ride exploring the eastern side of the concession. This ride moves through a variety of game areas fording numerous hippo channels in this truly remote area.



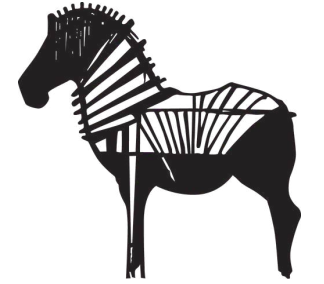
DAY 5

A full days ride back to camp picnicing at a different spot and completing the journey you set out on two days before.

The route takes you through a chain or rain pans, a great contrast to the open flood plains. Mopane forests and acacia woodlands offer a good variety of food for elephant, kudu and giraffe. Breeding herds of elephant enjoy the security of the dense forest and should the pans be holding water, zebra, wildebeest and buffalo can also be found.

A chance to swim your horse back into Kujwana Camp if water levels permit.

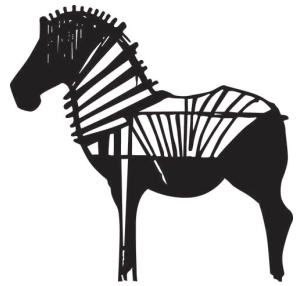




DAY 6

A morning ride and chance to try a new horse perhaps one of our lovely homebreds, a wonderful Boerped or one of our many fun Arabs.

A long lunch before a rest then a drive to a bush dinner and night drive back to camp. A chance to look for nocturnal creatures and do some star gazing.



DAY 7

A morning ride searching for any game that has eluded you so far! Enjoy a barbecue lunch by the pool hosted (and cooked!) by your guide.

After siesta an activity of your choice or simply find a shady spot and enjoy the views with a good book.





DAY 8

A morning ride around the East of Kujwana camp. Shady rain pans and thick riverine forest make this ride an ideal time to track a breeding herd of elephants. Break for a snack on the edge of a hippo pool, before riding on into more open areas with the chance of picking up a herd of buffalo moving through.

In the evening, enjoy an early dinner in camp before heading out on a night drive to our platforms where you will spend a night sleeping under the stars. Fall asleep to the sound of the little pearl spotted owls who share the trees with you.





DAY 9

Awake in the trees on your platform and enjoy a beautiful sunrise over the Qwaapu area, with the game strolling through the floodplain below. After a bush breakfast you'll make your way back to Kujwana Camp with a game drive and walk.

In the afternoon there will be a 2 hour evening ride followed by sunset drinks on one of the flood plains. A lovely way to end an active day.

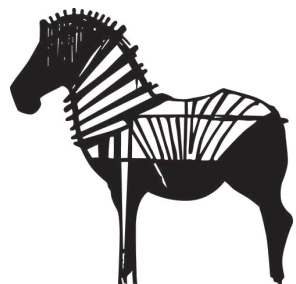


DAY 10

Your final full morning ride. Head east towards Beacon and Lion Island. These are two very large islands in the area, which are cut off from Kujwana by the Qwaapu River. Plenty of chance for splashy canters when the flood waters are around camp.

In the afternoon, enjoy a bird walk with the opportunity to learn more about the traditional uses of the plants and trees of the area.





DAY 11

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Early morning game ride if departure time permits before brunch and goodbye for now!.
